BASKING SHARK

Basking sharks are the second largest fish (and shark) on the planet. These filter feeders can open their mouths up to a metre wide.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: Cetorhinus maximus

DISTRIBUTION: Worldwide, near the surface in cold to warm waters, in deeper water in tropical and equatorial regions.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 12m

HABITAT: Mainly coastal but migrates at depth (200-1000m) in the open ocean.
