

BLUE SHARK

Blue sharks are regarded by many as the most heavily fished shark on the planet. They are also the most migratory of any species, travelling over 9000km during their yearly migration.

SCIENTIFIC NAME: *Prionace glauca*

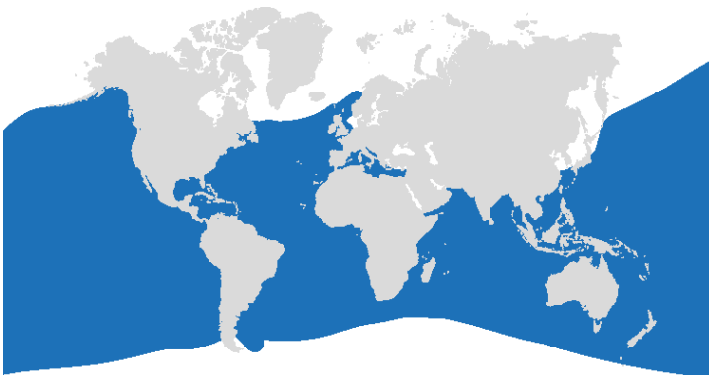
DIET: Small fishes and carrion.

DISTRIBUTION: Worldwide in temperate and tropical oceanic waters. Possibly the most wide-ranging of any shark species.

MAXIMUM SIZE: 3.84m

HABITAT: 0-1000m in the open-ocean. Sometimes closer to shores at night.
