



## LARGETOOTH SAWFISH

The Largetooth Sawfish is characterised by its long, flat snout or 'rostrum' studded with teeth, resembling a saw. They swing this from side to side to stun their prey.

**SCIENTIFIC NAME:** *Pristis pristis*

**DIET:** Benthic crustaceans and other invertebrates.

**DISTRIBUTION:** Atlantic Ocean from West Africa to the Caribbean and the Gulf of Mexico. It also extends into the Indo-Pacific.

**MAXIMUM SIZE:** 3m

**HABITAT:** Shallow coastal waters in tropical, sub-tropical and warm temperate regions.
