SCIENTIFIC NAME: Carcharhinus

melanopterus

MAXIMUM SIZE: 180cm

DIET: Small reef fishes, crustaeceans and molluscs

HABITAT: Very shallow water on coral reefs and reef flats. Rarely offshore or in brackish waters.
