SCIENTIFIC NAME:

Sphyrna mokarran

MAXIMUM SIZE:

550-610cm

DIET:

Smaller fish, smaller sharks, octopuses, squid, and crustaceans.

DISTRIBUTION:

Worldwide. Tropical seas.

HABITAT:

Coastal-pelagic and semi-oceanic. Close inshore to well off-shore. 1-300m or more.
